At Thame Freight, our green policy applies both in the office, and on the road.

#### In the office

- We keep a printing to a minimum; only crucial documents get printed.
- We recycle whenever it is possible.
- Whenever feasible, we reuse paper, and print in black and white, rather than colour for all our internal documents.

#### On the road

- Our vehicles are regularly updated to ensure we're running the latest euro-spec engines where financially viable.
- All vehicles are well maintained to ensure they're always running efficiently as possible.
- Our drivers drive in an eco-safe manner. This reduces fuel consumption, wear and tear to increase service life, and reduces the likelihood of damaging cargo.

#### Other Services

- We sell a selection of used, good condition boxes to reduce waste.
- We sell environmentally friendly recyclable packaging materials, including card-based bubble wrap, and paper-based packing tape.

To reduce "dead miles" (miles driven unloaded), we are members of networks connecting thousands of couriers and freight forwarders, meaning we can collect loads on otherwise empty journeys. This goes towards reducing the number of vehicles on the nation's roads.

Certain jobs can be co-loaded (with customer permission) This reduces the number of vehicles on the road. Another benefit of this to end user is lower transport costs than a dedicated vehicle, whilst being friendlier to the environment.
